

In 2020 almost **500 Million** people will be living in Urban India



Plight of urban services in Indian cities

- No Indian city has 24 hours of water supply and where available, duration of water supply varies between 1-6 hours (IIHS, 2011) with almost 40-50% losses in transmission and distribution.
- Urban centers across the country generate about 115,000 MT of municipal solid waste daily and the per capita waste generation in cities varies between 0.2–0.6 kg per day.
- Given the changing pattern of consumption in across urban centers, the per capita waste generated is increasing by 1.3% per annum (Vaidya, 2009).
- As of 2010, more than 30% of the urban households had access to only community latrines or toilets.
- Nearly 94% of India's cities do not even have partial sewage networks (HPEC, 2010).




Growth in Electricity Consumption by Building Sector



At a 12% growth rate electricity consumption of building sector will increase almost **3 times** by 2020


